Henshaws has a range of varied services, all designed to support and develop businesses. Services range from disability awareness training, to a print service and specialist Brailling service.



This 1-hour practical seminar will give your staff the confidence, skills and knowledge to welcome customers with disabilities into your company.

WORK PLACEMENTS



Work placements in local businesses make a huge difference to students. The practical experience helps young people to develop employability skills for the future.

Usually scheduled for half a day per week, students attend their work placement with a job coach from Henshaws staff team who stays with them to support them throughout the work experience. The job coach will liaise with the employer and take care of all the paperwork.



Recent and current work placements include Harrogate Hospital Radio, The Cone Exchange, Berwins Solicitors, Horticap, Brookside Nurseries, Bebra Gardens, SCOPE, Julie's Café and our own purpose built Arts and Crafts Centre shop and cafe.
