

DETAILED SELECTION INFORMATION

TOKYO OLYMPICS 2021



This document, which is to be read in conjunction with the document entitled General Selection Procedure, contains details of particular performances which will be considered during selection for the event named above, and the deadline for each step in the selection process to which this document relates.

The Selection Panel will take into account performances at the events listed below. These events are categorised in columns A or B (A being the most relevant and B being the least) corresponding with the likely importance to the Selection Panel when considering final selection of the team for this Event. Please note, however, that the Selection Panel is obliged to consider other relevant factors and performances in the events listed below will not, in themselves, guarantee selection.

*the quality and depth of the athlete field will be assessed for all events prior to the selection meeting

Specific Eligibility Criteria

GB Taekwondo must have had an NOC qualified place for the games before selection can proceed. In addition to the eligibility requirements set out in paragraph 2 of the General Selection Procedure, all athletes must satisfy the below requirements of:

1. Age Requirements (Art. 4.1 Competition Rules and Interpretation): All athletes participating in the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 must be born on/or before 31 December 2004 (at least 17 years of age)
2. The World Taekwondo Federation, in particular that the athlete has been ranked higher than 21st place at least once in the WT rankings between December 2020 and June 2021; and
3. Having a British Passport which expires no less than 6 months after the Games;
4. Have satisfied any nationality, anti-doping and/or other eligibility requirements imposed by the BOA, IF or IOC

Under exceptional circumstances where Team GB receive and approve (as its discretion) a Tripartite Commission invitation place, an athlete must have achieved **one** of the following:

- A medal winner (1st, 2nd or 3rd place) at any of the competitions listed on the WT calendar between May 2019 and April 2021
- Be ranked higher than 21st place in the WT world ranking list at least once between May 2019 and April 2021
- Advancement to, at least, the round 16 at the WT World Taekwondo Championships 2019
- Advancements to, at least, the quarter-finals of either the European Taekwondo Championships held between May 2018 and April 2021
- Be a winner of the National Taekwondo Championships between May 2019 and April 2021

GB Taekwondo reserves the right to request sight of the originals of any copy documents supplied to demonstrate athlete's eligibility.

Timing of the Selection Process

The deadline for receipt by GB Taekwondo of the completed expression of interest form will be **31st March 2021**.

The selection meeting will be held on **12th May 2021**.

Athlete's will be notified of selection decision by **13th May 2021**.

Athlete Replacement – post-Delegation Registration Meeting (DRM)

In the event of there being a query over the ability of an athlete to be able to compete to the best of his/her ability after the DRM due to an injury or illness the following procedure will be adhered to:

- (a) Team GB's Chief Medical Officer can require an athlete to undergo a medical examination to determine his/her fitness to participate. This examination will be carried out by Team GB's Chief Medical Officer or another doctor delegated by him/her. If the athlete fails the medical examination he/she will be withdrawn from the Team and the Governing Body may (if appropriate) nominate a replacement athlete in accordance with its selection policy.
- (b) If the athlete passes the medical examination carried out in accordance with 7.1.5 a) above but GB Taekwondo and/or the BOA still have concerns over whether or not the athlete is able to compete to a level which would ordinarily have been expected of the athlete due to the underlying injury or illness, the Chef de Mission (in consultation with the Governing Body) can require the athlete to undergo a set of pre-determined sports specific performance tests.
- (c) The tests will be conducted under the guidance of the sport's Team Leader (or his/her delegate e.g. team physiotherapist) and a BOA representative or delegate will be present (if possible/available). If the athlete fails the test (which can be undertaken on more than one occasion and within a short time frame if appropriate), he/she will be withdrawn from the Team on medical grounds and, if appropriate, a replacement can be nominated by GB Taekwondo in accordance with the selection policy.
